

TRANS-BRIDGE LINES REDUCED FARE POLICY

We **ONLY** accept the following forms of ID to purchase reduced fare tickets.
Drivers **MUST** check valid ID prior to accepting tickets when boarding coach.

Trans-Bridge will not delay the departure of any given bus, due to passengers who are unable to board the coach with a reduced fare ticket, when not having the proper ID. Reduced fare tickets are available from any of our authorized Ticket Agents. Reduced fare tickets are not available for purchase at Newark Airport, JFK Airport, Jersey City and the Wall Street area. Drivers do not sell reduced fare tickets at any time.

SENIOR CITIZENS AND MILITARY PERSONNEL

Senior Citizens (62 and older)

- Driver's License, Passport, or Birth Certificate
- State-Issued Non-Driver's ID (issued by State's Department of Motor Vehicles)
- Medicaid or Medicare ID
- NJ Transit Reduced Fare Card or ID

Senior Citizens (65 and older)

- ID for Senior Citizens (62 and older)
- Pennsylvania Senior Citizen Transit ID or PACE card
- MTA Reduced Fare MetroCard
- PATH Senior Fare Card

Military Personnel and their Dependents

The following military personnel are entitled to this fare: **Active Duty, Reserve, National Guard or Retired members from the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard.**
