

### Branchburg Park & Ride Update



At this time, parking spaces will not be added to the Branch-

burg Park and Ride. Branchburg Township, the owner of the lot, told us that they have actually oversold permits to the lot and cannot expand due to wetlands on the outlying areas of the current parking lot.

In light of these circumstances, we are actively searching for alternative locations to alleviate the burden placed on our customers who park at the Branchburg Park and Ride. Currently, the only feasible parking alternative is for passengers to use our Flemington Location at Liberty Village.

While we have explored the possibility, with the NJDOT, of possibly adding another pickup location in the Route 202 corridor, we do not have immediate plans to open an additional stop.

We will continue to monitor the Branchburg situation and will update our commuters with more information as it becomes available.
